- Equipment: Use your smartphone and film in natural light (early morning or late afternoon) for the best quality.
- Filming Tips: Capture authentic moments like checking melon ripeness, harvesting with equipment, or showcasing your farm and team.

1.1 Example 1-Minute Video Structure

- 0:00-0:05: Intro (Gday, Im Your Name from Your Farm in Location!)
- 0:05-0:30: Show expertise (e.g., checking ripeness, harvesting, or drip irrigation).
- 0:30-0:50: Action shot (e.g., cutting a melon or handing out samples at a market).

2. What to Share (Key Themes)

Highlight what makes your melons and farm unique with these content ideas:

- Melon Quality: Show how you ensure top-notch melons. Film: Close-ups of inspecting melons (tapping, checking skin, testing brix, or washing rockmelons and honeydews).
- Harvesting: Share tricks for picking perfect melons. *Film:* Cutting melons, handling them gently to avoid bruises, or checking the melon picker.
- Sustainability: Highlight eco-friendly practices. *Film:* Irrigation setups or beefriendly fields.
- Consumer Education: Teach people how to pick and enjoy melons. *Film:* Picking, inspecting, preparing melons, or sharing favorite recipes.
- **Melon Team and Pickers:** Celebrate your team. *Film:* Team harvesting, training new pickers, or sharing a laugh in the field.
